Applications Start Soon

USDA will soon take applications for the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP), and agricultural producers will apply through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA). For more information, visit **farmers.gov/CFAP**

HOW TO PREPARE NOW

You can start gathering information on your farm's recent sales and inventory, as well as completing eligibility forms at **farmers.gov/CFAP**

Some of the info you'll need includes:

- Tax Identification Number
- Farming operating structure
- Adjusted Gross Income

If you have worked with FSA previously, much of this information is likely on file.



HOW TO APPLY ONCE SIGNUP BEGINS

1. Call your FSA county office to make an appointment. You can find your local Service Center at **farmers.gov/CFAP**

2. FSA will work with you via phone, email, fax, mail, or online tools to receive and complete your application.
