# Applications Start Soon

USDA will soon take applications for the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP), and agricultural producers will apply through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA). For more information, visit [farmers.gov/CFAP](https://farmers.gov/CFAP)

## HOW TO PREPARE NOW

You can start gathering information on your farm's recent sales and inventory, as well as completing eligibility forms at [farmers.gov/CFAP](https://farmers.gov/CFAP)

Some of the info you'll need includes:

- **Tax identification number**
- **Farming operating structure**
- **Adjusted gross income**

If you have worked with FSA previously, much of this information is likely on file.



## HOW TO APPLY ONCE SIGNUP BEGINS

**1. Call your FSA county office to make an appointment.** You can find your local Service Center at [farmers.gov/CFAP](https://farmers.gov/CFAP)

**2. FSA will work with you** via phone, email, fax, mail, or online tools to receive and complete your application.
